



## UNDP Expression of Interest No. 155

The United Nations Development Program in Chile (UNDP-Chile), in the context of the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer and on behalf of the project “*CHI/FOA/48/INV/161 Terminal Umbrella Project for phase-out of the use of CFC-11 in the manufacture of polyurethane foam in Chile*”, is seeking for interested companies to supply **13 pneumatic (air driven), mobile, high pressure, two component dispensers and related accessories to produce rigid PU foam for spray foam and pour-in-place applications, capacity 7 - 10 kg/min.** Qualified institutions are hereby invited to submit their Expression of Interest (EOI) along with the following documents:

- Detailed description of the institution, including information on fields of work, legal incorporation, resources and infrastructure, financial background.
- Catalog of rigid PU foam dispensers.
- List of similar projects in which the institution has provided equipment, including client contact details.
- Reference list for major clients in the past three years.
- If applicable, a list of countries to which the company has provided equipment in the Framework of the Montreal Protocol.

Companies are expected to provide the following services along with the delivery of the above-mentioned equipment:

- Installation and commissioning of equipment
- Trial runs
- Operator training, in Spanish
- Basic maintenance training, in Spanish
- Adequate post-sales service (maintenance and spare parts) in Santiago de Chile
- Manuals and Parts catalogue, in Spanish

Interested Companies must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services in Santiago de Chile. Companies will be selected in accordance with the procedure set out in the UNDP Procurement Guidelines and UNDP Financial Rules and Regulations.

EOI from suppliers failing to provide the request information will be disregarded. Invitations to bid and any subsequent purchase order will be issued in accordance with the rules and procedures of UNDP

This EOI does not entail any commitment on the part of UNDP, either financial or otherwise. UNDP reserves the right to accept or reject any or all EOI without incurring any obligation to inform the affected applicant(s) of the grounds.
